Jane Larson Session!!!

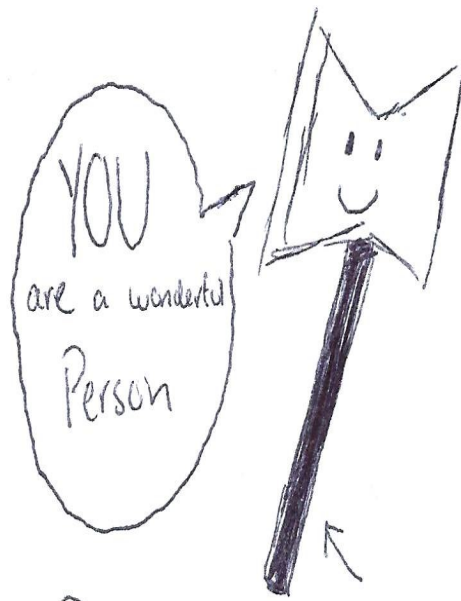
