Alaska Legal Services provides counsel for veterans.
- Lisa Williamson and Lisa Boyles are helping Debbie Lowndes with the Finance Committee. Copies of the budget are in mail boxes. There will be talk about finances at the DEC meeting on Sunday. Debbie will be on the phone to answer any questions.
- Lisa thanked everyone for their support in the last several days. She is here this weekend because that is what her mother wanted.

They are not doing a calendar for 2021 because finances are not as good as last year. She thanked her home family for running with this one. She wishes her mom could be there.
